BOIL WATER ADVISORY LIFTED

The Carroll County Water Authority (“CCWA”) has lifted the boil water advisory that was issued on February 21st for CCWA customers located north of Highway 78 and City of Temple residents. Laboratory results released earlier today indicate that water supplied within the advisory area meets all regulatory requirements and is safe for consumption.

Residents in the advisory area may continue to experience cloudy or milky looking water caused by air entrapped in the water. If viewed in a glass, the tiny air bubbles will slowly rise to the top of the water and dissipate. CCWA will continue flushing in the distribution system to help alleviate this issue.
