

PUBLIC MEETING

The Carroll County Water Authority (CCWA) hereby gives notice that a public meeting will be held to discuss a water improvements project funded by Georgia's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) on April 30th 2019 at 10:00 a.m. local time in the conference room at the offices of the Carroll County Water Authority at the following address: 556 Old Bremen Road, Carrollton Georgia 30117.

The proposed project involves improvements and upgrades to CCWA's Snake Creek Water Treatment Plant that currently consists of a raw water storage pond, four "up-flow" contact clarifiers and multimedia filters, chemical feed systems, a 1.5 MMG clearwell, a high service pump station and two solids retention ponds. The new project will generally consist of a new rapid mix, flocculation basins, high-rate (plate) sedimentation, two additional multi-media filters, a chemical building and chemical systems, a second 1.5 MMG clearwell, a new high service pump station, new solids handling ponds, a SCADA system, an administration building and a maintenance building. The new project is designed to improve the reliability and capacity of the Snake Creek plant and provide for future growth.

The purposes of the public meeting are to:

1. Inform the public of the need for improvements to CCWA's water facilities.
2. Comply with the requirements of Georgia's Rules for Safe Drinking Water and with the public participation requirements of Georgia's Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Environmental Review Process.
3. Encourage public involvement in the development of CCWA's efforts to improve its water production facilities.

During the public meeting the CCWA will attempt to identify public preferences for alternative methods of improving the CCWA's water production facilities. These alternatives will be evaluated and included in CCWA's Facilities Plan and Environmental Information Document, the major planning document covering the water system. These documents are available for public inspection through the date of the public meeting at CCWA's offices located at 556 Old Bremen Road Carrollton Georgia 30117 during normal business hours.

Your participation is encouraged and considered essential to the selection and development of the final plan to be adopted prior to its approval by the State of Georgia, Department of Natural Resources.
